### 5. READY FOR PLAY

All players must be ready for play prior to the start of the game. Any player arriving after the opening face-off will not be allowed to take the field until half time. This rule is waived in the following cases; 1. Players traveling from Orange County. 2. If a team will forfeit due to a lack of the required amount of players to field a legal game.

# 6. FANS / PARENTS / SPECTATORS

No one except the players are allowed in the bench area at any time during a game. All spectators must sit in the bleachers. Only certified TVLAX coaches are allowed to coach a team. Certification is determined solely by the Director.

# 7. GOALIES

Goalies are allowed to play in other games where a team does not have a goalie or a player who has played goalie for their team previously. Approval from the Official is necessary. No forfeit will occur.

#### 8. FORFEITS

Any team that does not have 7 players and 1 goalkeeper when the Official is ready to begin the game, will forfeit the game. The game will still be played but other players from the previous or the next game are eligible to participate. All statistics will count.

## 9. EJECTIONS / PENALTIES

Penalty time begins when the penalized player is off the field and the whistle blows to resume play. A player will be ejected if he gets 3 fouls in a game. A 2-minute foul is equal to 1 foul. A 5-minute foul is equal to 2 fouls. Game ejections due to fighting or maligning will be 3 fouls and a 7-minute penalty. All ejected players due to fighting or maligning must leave the Center immediately to avoid any further escalation. Any player ejected 2 times during the season is ineligible to play in any game for the remainder of the season.

# 10. CREASE PLAY

- 1. All goalkeepers will have 4 second to leave the crease after gaining possession of the ball. This crease violation will cause a change in possession.
- 2. It is illegal for any player in possession of the ball to run into their defensive crease. This crease violation will cause a change of possession. Crease violations on the offensive side of the field will be considered a "Play On" until it is determined by the Official that the violating team does not regain possession of the ball. If the non-violating team gains possession of the ball, no call is made and said team gets one pass or ten yards running with the ball for the "Play On' to be called off.

# 11. ELIGIBILTY, STATISTICS, & POST SEASON

A player must play in 6 games to be eligible for post season awards. Only the top 25 players in each of the statistical categories will be posted on the website. The Director, TVLAX coaches, the Officials and the score keeper will determine the award honors. All games are played, rain or shine.
